

A Crochet Apple

I ended up writing my own pattern for the cute apples I made to accompany my Pirum Parum pears (pattern by Tournicote). I am very happy with my apples' size and shape - I wanted them to look like a real apple with a tapered bottom and a dimple at the top, and just the perfect size to match the pears too. Using 8 ply (DK weight) yarn and a 4mm hook this apple is approximately 13cm tall from the bottom to the tip of the leaf. Roughly the same size as a real life large apple!



This sweet apple pattern is now available in [my Etsy shop](#) - it only costs \$3.50 Australian (\$2.50 US at the time of writing) so it won't break the bank, and is a good starter amigurumi project.
